1. Vs. 1 Who is Sheba? Why is he called 'a man of Belial'? Find other scriptures that reference 'Belial'.
2. Vs. 2 Once again a divided nation. What caused them to divide? What does the Bible teach about 'cleaving to one another'?
3. Vs. 3 Why did David put these 10 concubines in 'ward'?
4. Vs. 4-5 Why would Amasa tarry? What scriptures can you find that deal with procrastination?
5. Vs. 6-8 Now King David sends Abishai and Joab follows with his men and others. Who are these Cherethites and Pelethites and why are they fighting for David?
6. Vs. 9-13 What do you think about Joab and his actions? Why did he kill his cousin?
7. Vs. 14-19 Describe in your own words what this wise woman is saying to Joab.
8. Vs. 20-26 Joab states that Sheba 'lifted up his hand against the king'. In our time today apply this with examples of how people 'lift up their hand against our King Jesus'. In verse 23 it looks like Joab has succeeded in regaining his position but God will repay unrighteousness. Find scriptures that show this.
