

2 Samuel Chapter 22 Questions

We see mainly Psalms 18 here in this chapter. But other Psalms are also referenced. It is definitely a Psalm of Thanksgiving to God.

- 1) Verses 1-3 David begins this Psalm by stating how God is his firm foundation. What does it take to truly have God as our foundation?
- 2) Verses 4-7 David cries out to God here for answers, God listens. How do we maintain the privilege of God listening to our cries?
- 3) Verse 8 How, when and why is God "wroth?"
- 4) Verses 9-16 The powerful move of God, because of David's prayers. What do these scriptures tell you, about the way in which God moves?
- 5) Verses 17-25 God responds to David, because of the man David is. What can we learn from these verses?
- 6) Verses 26-28 Look closely at the words, Upright, Pure, Froward, Unsavoury, Afflicted and Haughty. What is the meaning of each? What are we to learn from these verses?
- 7) Verses 29-34 Our victories, like David's victories come from God. How do these verses help you at difficult times? What does it mean in verse 34, "He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places."
- 8) Verses 35-37 He teaches us how to fight, yet it is "gentleness" that makes us great. How?
- 9) Verse 38-43 We have to fight our battles to the very end. What do you see in these verses that help us to keep our focus, while in battle?
- 10) Verse 44-46 What is David saying in these verses?
- 11) Verse 47-51 Beautiful verses that sum up this Psalm. What in particular stands out to you in these final verses?
